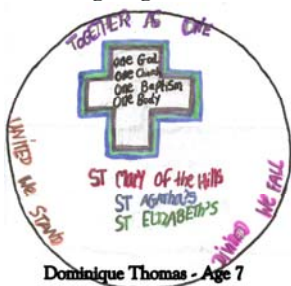

Two Programs for Women of Faith

MOMS: Ministry of Mothers Sharing

MOMS, the Ministry of Mothers Sharing, is a national faith-based program developed by the Sisters of St. Benedict to awaken in women an awareness of their inner sacred selves. And, you don't have to be a traditional mom to participate; previous participants have included women with children at home, grandmothers, step-moms and empty nesters. The program is for any woman who feels that she would like to grow in her spirituality, using a Personal Journal as a guide along with a facilitated discussion each week, lasting two hours. Topics of discussion include Self-Esteem and Self-Acceptance, Personal Growth, Stress, Worries and Anxiety, Everyday Spirituality and Feelings. The new sessions will begin at St. Mary of the Hills the week of April 26 and conclude with the Celebration of New Beginnings dinner on June 10. Specific days and times will be determined based on participant availability. Babysitting can also be arranged if necessary. There is an optional \$30.00 fee to cover the cost of materials. 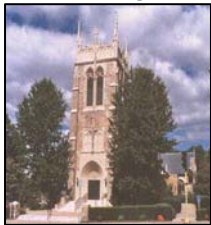
